

Certified Data Protection Supervisor (CDPS) Training

About the CDPS Programme

The Certified Data Protection Supervisor (CDPS) is a practitioner-level training programme developed by the Data Protection Commission of Ghana. It equips professionals with the practical skills and legal understanding required to support and supervise data protection compliance activities in their organisations.

The training is delivered by **Commission-accredited institutions**, but **assessment**, **certification**, and **results are managed solely by the Data Protection Commission**.

Objectives of the Training

At the end of the course, participants will be able to:

- Interpret and apply key provisions of the Data Protection Act, 2012 (Act 843)
- Support internal compliance frameworks aligned with the Eight Data Protection Principles
- Maintain proper documentation such as ROPA and consent records
- Facilitate data subject requests and reporting of data breaches
- Act as internal champions of **privacy**, **accountability**, **and data governance**

Training Overview

- Duration: 5 Working Days
- **Delivery**: In-person or virtual (depending on institution)
- Mode: Facilitator-led sessions with exercises, policy walkthroughs, and case studies
- Assessment: Final examination and evaluation administered by the Commission
